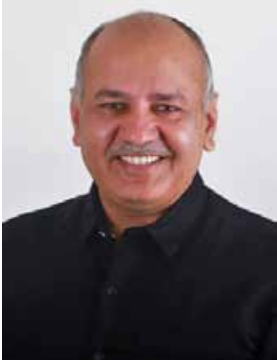

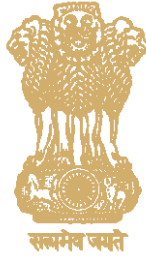

Delhi Cabinet approves Smart Urban Farming Initiative

Delhi will witness a sharp rise in its green cover under the Smart Urban Farming Initiative and public participation will help take the movement forward.

The Delhi Cabinet, led by Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal, on Wednesday gave its approval to the Smart Urban Farming Initiative.

Delhi will witness a sharp rise in its green cover under the Smart Urban Farming Initiative and public participation will help take the movement forward.

While presenting the proposal, the officials informed the Chief Minister that the initiative is part of the urban farming and terrace gardening scheme. The Smart urban farming initiative comprises two parts — urban farming training workshops and entrepreneurship training programmes.

The programme aims to raise citizen awareness of urban farming and to give a boost to the creation of green jobs in Delhi. It was further proposed to conduct 400 Urban Farming Awareness Workshops for citizens where 40 master trainers and 10,000 citizens will be trained; and 600 Entrepreneurship Training Programmes for citizens across Delhi through industry partners where 15,000 citizens will be given training workshops on a cluster basis. After due deliberation over the proposal, the Cabinet gave its approval to the scheme.

Kejriwal said, “During our budget announcements, we had taken up a key initiative to promote urban farming. Urban Farming is a unique project where people from all walks of life can start small-scale farming of fruits and vegetables within the confines of their balconies and terraces. The Delhi Government will train citizens to grow these crops in the urban setting. To promote the scheme, we will support urban farmers with seeds and other essentials.”

He said, “The initiative has been divided into two major components. First, those who want to grow fruits and vegetables for self-sustenance and consumption. Such people will get high-quality, organic vegetables in the comfort of their household and save money on shopping for groceries. Second, those who want to make a business out of this. This will help many citizens and especially housewives gain extra income through this source. It will act as an employment opportunity for them.”

Kejriwal said, “We will be hiring experts at a large scale for this project. We will tie up with the Indian Agriculture Research Institute for the same. The Delhi Government will organise 400 ward-level workshops under the first component of self-consumption. Another 600 workshops will be organised under the entrepreneurship component. We aim to educate and empower 25,000 families through these 1,000 workshops in the first year.”

To promote kitchen gardens, Delhi govt takes up 'smart urban farming'

Following the approval of the cabinet, experts will now be hired on a large-scale basis to conduct 400 awareness workshops and 600 entrepreneurship training programmes across the capital, chief minister Arvind Kejriwal said.

In the general public initiative, 40 master trainers will also be trained by the Delhi government and they will then assist the public and resident bodies across the city in taking forward the project.

To promote green jobs in the capital, the Delhi cabinet on Wednesday approved the 'smart urban farming' initiative, through which it aims to popularise rooftop farming, both for self consumption and as an entrepreneurship venture, officials in the know of the development said.

Following the approval of the cabinet, experts will now be hired on a large-scale basis to conduct 400 awareness workshops and 600 entrepreneurship training programmes across the capital, chief minister Arvind Kejriwal said.

"During our budget announcements, we had taken up a key initiative to promote urban farming. This is a unique project whereby people from all walks of life can start small-scale farming of fruits and vegetables within the confines of their balconies and terraces. The Delhi government will train citizens to grow these plants in the urban setting. We will support urban farmers by providing them with seeds and other essentials," said Kejriwal on Wednesday.

In the first year, the government aims to help around 25,000 families, with around 10,000 citizens expected to be trained on how to grow vegetables on rooftops for self consumption, while around 15,000 citizens are expected to be trained in taking up home farming as an entrepreneurial venture.

The project will connect the Tughlakabad Fort, Ghalya-suddin's Tomb, Adilabad Fort and Nal-ka-Koi. "DMRC makes all possible efforts to locate its stations in the vicinity of residential and commercial areas so that maximum people can get full benefit of the alignment," the spokesperson said. "While the inter-station gap is 1.2km, in

Phase IV, meticulous planning has been done to ensure services to the maximum possible people residing in the area."

Though the 3.7-km gap between two stations is quite long, the Sangam Vihar Tigri- Maa Anandmayee Marg section

wa and Majlis Park (2.2km) and Mukundpur and Bhalsawa (2km). The DMRC spokesperson, however, said that the distances might be different after completion of the project.

Fruits of labour: Urban farming plan gets nod

New Delhi: To promote 'green jobs' in Delhi, chief minister Arvind Kejriwal-led cabinet approved a smart urban farming initiative on Wednesday.

Under the initiative, the Delhi government will train citizens for growing fruits and vegetables for both self-consumption and as an entrepreneurial venture. The move, said Kejriwal, will emerge as a unique solution to generate employment in the city.

The initiative was announced by the Delhi government in the Rozgar budget earlier this year. While presenting the budget, deputy chief minister Manish Sisodia had said that the initiative had the potential of generating 25,000 jobs in the next

five years. Under the budget, the AAP government had envisioned creation of 20 lakh new job opportunities in Delhi in five years.

Delhi will witness a sharp rise in its green cover under the urban farming initiative and public participation will help take the movement forward, Kejriwal said while addressing a press conference after the cabinet meeting.

"Urban farming is a unique project where people from all walks of life can start small-scale farming of fruits and vegetables within the confines of their balconies and terraces. The Delhi government will train citizens to grow these crops in the urban setting. To promote the scheme, we will support urban farmers with se-

The initiative will comprise urban farming training workshops and entrepreneurship training programmes.

"We will tie up with Indian Agriculture Research Institute to rope in experts in large numbers. The Delhi government will organise 400 ward-level workshops for those taking up urban farming for self-consumption of fruits and vegetables. Another

600 workshops will be organised under the entrepreneurship component. We aim to educate and empower 25,000 families through these 1,000 workshops in the first year," Kejriwal added.

The awareness workshops will be done in collaboration with IARI. These will include 2-day master trainer workshops as well. Weekly online sessions will be held later to clarify the doubts and discuss the queries of the citizens.

The entrepreneurship programme, however, will be undertaken by private partners on a cluster basis.

The government also form a Delhi Environment Protection Committee to systematically involve people to this cause and make them aware and monitor their training. The committee will include representatives of NGOs, RWs, environmental experts, and councillors.
